Cuando queremos decir cuándo, por cuánto tiempo o con qué frecuencia sucede algo, necesitamos usar adverbios de tiempo.

Generalmente se colocan al final de las oraciones.

Los más comunes en presente son:

NOW = ahora

TODAY = hoy

TONIGHT = esta noche

LATER = más tarde, luego, después

ALREADY = ya

AFTER = después

BEFORE = antes

FINALLY = finalmente

IN THE MORNING = por la mañana

IN THE AFTERNOON = por la tarde

IN THE EVENING = por la noche

NEXT = después

SOON = pronto

THEN = luego, después

SINCE = desde

EARLY = temprano

FOR = durante, por

THEN = entonces, después

Ejemplos:

Do you have any plan for **tonight**?

Finally, I want to eat breakfast.

I am going to school **now**.
