PASADO CON VERBOS REGULARES

¿Cómo se conjugan los verbos regulares?

Para conjugar los verbos regulares solo debes agregarles la terminación "**ed**", por ejemplo:

- **Work** (trabajar) - **Worked**
- **Ask** (preguntar) - **Asked**
- **Rest** (descansar) - **Rested**

Con verbos terminados en "E", solo se les agrega la "D"

- **Hope** (esperar) - **Hoped**
- **Use** (usar) - **Used**
- **Believe** (creer) - **Believed**

Si el verbo termina una consonante y en "y", remplazas esta última letra por una "i". Después le agregas terminación "**ed**".

- **Carry** (cargar) - **Carried**
- **Cry** (llorar) - **Cried**

Por último, en algunos verbos que terminan en consonante deberás duplicar la letra final antes de agregar la terminación "**ed**". Deberás hacerlo cuando el acento de la palabra vaya en la última sílaba. Por ejemplo:

- **Stop** (parar) - **Stopped**
- **Clap** (aplaudir) - **Clapped**
- **Program** (programar) - **Programmed**

NOTA: En negación y en pregunta el verbo va en forma simple y se le agrega el auxiliar de pasado que es DID.

Ejemplos: I did not stop. = No me detuve

He didn't clap. = Él no aplaudió

Did they cry? = ¿Ellos lloraron?

IAN FLEMING

Ian Fleming was born in London on 25th May, 1905. He studied at Eton College, the Royal Military Academy, Sandhurst and the Universities of Munich and Geneva. Fleming worked in journalism, banking, newspaper management and as a personal assistant to the Director of Naval Intelligence during the second World War. Fleming became famous as the creator of the spy, James Bond. His first successful book was *Casino Royale*. Between 1953 and his death on 12th August 1964 he wrote eighteen books. His most famous books are: *Goldfinger*, *Diamonds are Forever*, *Live and Let Die*, *You only live twice*. The actors Sean Connery, Roger Moore, Pierce Brosnan have played the part of James Bond in the films based on Fleming's books.
