



Expressions for Past Tense

English, we use the simple past to talk about when things happened. There are a number of words and phrases that are often used to show when an action situation or in the happened past. We call them time adverbials. Here are the some of most common ones.

Last	Ago	Yesterday
last night	10 minutes ago	yesterday
last Sunday	an hour ago	yesterday morning
last week	three days ago	yesterday afternoon
last weekend	a week ago	yesterday evening
last year	a month ago	the day before yesterday
last month	a year ago	

Time adverbial: ago

We use time reference + ago to show how far back in the past something happened



Examples:

- The movie ended five minutes ago.
- The plane landed two hours ago.
- My son was born six months ago.
- Her husband died ten years ago.
- I took that photo many years ago.
- I came to this city a long time ago.

Time adverbial: last

We use last + time reference to mean the most recent or nearest to the present day time



Time adverbial: yesterday

We use yesterday or yesterday + morning / afternoon / evening to talk about the day before today



Examples:

- Charles wore a suit to work yesterday.
- We got up early yesterday morning.
- She left the hospital yesterday afternoon.
- Yesterday evening joel called me.

NOTE: We use *last night* NOT yesterday night.

We also use the expression the day before yesterday to mean "two days ago".


First, think what the most important events of the history of your country are in your opinion. Then, choose five and write them in order. Number 1 is the most important. Use past time expressions to say when the events happened.


