AFFIRMATIVE FORM

Simple Present	Simple Past
I play volleyball.	I played volleyball.
You play volleyball.	You played volleyball.
He plays volleyball.	He played volleyball.

NEGATIVE FORM

Simple Present	Simple Past
I do not play volleyball.	I did not play volleyball.
You do not play volleyball.	You did not play volleyball.
He does not play volleyball.	He did not play volleyball.

QUESTIONS

Simple Present	Simple Past
Do I play volleyball?	Did I play volleyball?
Do you play volleyball?	Did you play volleyball?
Does he play volleyball?	Did he play volleyball?

SOME VERBS USED IN LIKES AND DISLIKES

These verbs are followed by verbs ending with ING form

But with WOULD use an infinitive form

Example: I would like to play soccer.

Enjoy	Like
Hate	Dislike
Detest	Enjoy

SOME EXAMPLES

I like eating ice cream	I don't like eating ice cream
You love watching sport	You don't love watching soccer games
She is crazy about sports	She is not crazy about sports
He is fond of chocolate	He isn't fond of chocolate
We are huge fans of soccer	We aren't huge fans of soccer
